Section: Cell Phone and other Electronic Devices Policy	Date Created/Revised:
<p>In order to provide a quiet environment in the library, cell phones are not to be used for the purpose of making or receiving phone calls. If you do need to use you phone for this purpose, you may do so only in the designated areas of the entryways. Cell phones should be turned off or set to silent while you are in the library.</p> <p>All electronic equipment accessing sites that generate sound require the use of headphones and the volume level must be set low enough that it cannot be heard by others.</p> <p>Electrical cords on approved items must be kept out of aisles and cannot in any manner create a tripping hazard.</p> <p>Library patrons with cell phone or other electronic device usage that violates our behavior policy on disturbances, creating a disturbance by making noise, talking loudly or engaging in other disruptive conduct, will be asked to leave the building.</p>
